

BIO 399: INTERNSHIP OBJECTIVES

This form is to be completed by the student and the internship site supervisor. **The completed form should be turned in to the Bio 399 internship coordinator by the first week of the quarter** in which the internship is being performed.

Student intern agrees to:

- 1) Work > 3 hr/wk for each credit received
 - 2) Write a final paper that will be evaluated by the Bio 399 instructor or a designated faculty sponsor. The paper must not simply be a record of the student's internship experience, but instead should address a related research topic. The paper should integrate the research findings obtained during the internship with information from additional sources (e.g., original articles, reviews, etc.).

- 3) Fill out an evaluation of the internship site at the conclusion of the internship

Internship Site Supervisor agrees to:

- 1) Provide suitable guidance during the internship. The organization should demonstrate genuine interest in integrating the student as a team member of the organization. Internship assignments should require creative problem solving and not be limited to repetitive or routine tasks.
